- 1. 2 Corinthians 11:14-15
- 2. We are not to marvel at what Satan can do, he can even look like a messenger of God Matthew 16:23
- 3. The word marvel is also translated in the New King James at wonder
- 4. There were times that people wondered or marveled at Jesus and His teaching Mark 5:20; 12:17; 15:5, 44; Luke 2:33; 20:26
- 5. There are at least two times that Jesus marveled Mark 6:6; Luke 7:9
- 6. Though Jesus marveled at their unbelief Mark 6:6 there is ample evidence to prove that Jesus is the Christ

II Discussion

- 1. The children of Israel were in unbelief in Hebrews 3:16-19
 - a. This is from Numbers 13-14
 - b. There was a glowing report from the spies that had walked the land Numbers 13:23-27
 - c. But or Nevertheless of verse 28 1)The people be strong verse 31, 2)cities are walled, 3)we are but grasshoppers verse 33
 - d. They wanted to go back into Egypt Numbers 14:4
 - e. The children of Israel refused to listen Numbers 14:6-10
 - f. Yet these people had seen what God could do. Numbers 14:11, 22
- 2. This is an example for us today Hebrews 4:11
 - a. There are scoffers today 2 Peter 3:1-5
 - b. Those who deny that God has made the universe Psalm 19:1; Genesis 1
 - c. Yet there is ample proof for us today John 20:30-31
 - i. John 2 shows Jesus the master over time and nature
 - ii. John 4:43-54 Jesus the master over disease, distance
 - iii. John 5:1-18 Jesus master over time, 38 years
 - iv. John 6:1-15 Jesus master over quantity and nature, fed 5,000 men
 - v. John 6:15-21 master over natural law, He walks on water
 - vi. John 9: Jesus master over misfortune man born blind
 - vii. John 11 Jesus master over death Lazarus is risen
 - d. The unbelief of the Israelites caused them to forget the burdens and problems in Egypt that they had prayed to God to be released from Numbers 14:4
 - e. We too can for get and are again entangled in the pollutions of this world 2 Peter 2:20-22
 - f. If one dies in unfaithfulness he will miss Heaven Hebrews 4:1, 10-11
