### II Discussion

1. Nature tells us that there is a God
  - a. Hebrews 3:4
  - b. The Law of procreation cannot be broken Genesis 1:12, 24, 25
  - c. God's law of gravity cannot be broken Genesis 1:16
    - i. We can use this law to fly, or send man into space,
    - ii. It takes great energy even to do this!
  - d. God's laws of seasons cannot be broken Genesis 1:14; 8:22
    - i. We can talk about the weather but no one but God can do anything about it. Mark 4:35-41
  - e. We cannot break God's natural law
2. God's spiritual law's cannot be broken
  - a. Adam and Eve Genesis 2:15-17; 3:1
  - b. Nadab and Abihu Leviticus 10:1-2
  - c. Moses could not Numbers 20:12 speak to the rock; Exodus 17:5-6 strike the rock here
  - d. Cain, Balaam, and Core could not Jude 11
  - e. David could not 2 Samuel 11 sin with Bathsheba; 2 Samuel 24:17 counting the people
  - f. Ananias and Sapphira could not Acts 5; Matthew 19:18 not steal,
  - g. We cannot break God's spiritual law
3. There are warnings from God that we cannot break His Laws
  - a. Examples are given for our warning 1 Corinthians 10:6, 11
  - b. When we keep the commands of God we will be blessed Hebrews 3-4
    - i. The children of Israel did receive the Law that flowed with milk and honey when they obeyed God.
  - c. Since we have these warnings that God's laws cannot be broken then the ball is in our court, it is up to us to keep the laws of God
  - d. When we do break these laws the consequence must be met Matthew 25; 2 Corinthians 5:10; John 5:28-29
4. God's laws concerning pardon cannot be set aside
  - a. God gave us His Son John 3:16
  - b. God gave us His Son to be a propitiation for our sins 1 John 2:2
  - c. There is something we must do to be saved, because we have broken God's laws Isaiah 59:1-2
    - i. We must realize we are sinners Romans 3:23

- ii. We must want forgiveness of these sins
- iii. We must be willing to do what God said to receive forgiveness
