  - a. The Book Hebrews 4:12; Ephesians 6:17
  - b. The Scriptures John 5:39; 2 Timothy 3:16
  - c. The oracles of God 1 Peter 4:11; Hebrews 5:12
  - d. Lively oracles Acts 7:38

  - 1. The Word of God is like fire Jeremiah 23:29
    - a. Fire can comfort 1 Thessalonians 4:18
    - b. Fire can purify 1 Peter 1:22; 1 John 4:1
    - c. Fire can destroy Acts 13:46
    - d. Fire can be hard to control Jeremiah 20:9; 1 Corinthians 9:16; Acts 8:4
  - 2. The Word of God is like a hammer Jeremiah 23:29
    - a. A hammer can break thing into pieces the hard and rebellious heart
    - b. Hammers are used to destroy, the Word of God must destroy some human theories Jeremiah 1:9-10
    - c. This hammer can build up Acts 20:32
    - d. We must learn to use the hammer correctly to do the best job
      - i. The hammer used incorrectly can put dents into wood
      - ii. Correct hammer for the correct job, framing hammer to do finishing work
  - 3. The Word of God is a sword Ephesians 6:16; Hebrews 4:12
    - a. Sword is an office and a defensive weapon
    - b. We must learn to use it correctly Acts 2:37; 7:54
    - c. We then must use it or it will become rusty
  - 4. The Word of God is light Psalm 119:105; 130
    - a. Sin is darkness in the Bible and the sinner is represented as being under this power Colossians 1:13
    - b. The only lamp some will see in our lives Matthew 5:14-16; 2 Peter 1:19; 1 Peter 2:9
    - c. Therefore we must have our lamps trimmed and brightly burning
  - 5. The Word of God is a mirror James 1:23-25; 2 Corinthians 3:18
    - a. What does a mirror show us? What we want to see?
    - b. The Bible reveals man to himself as he really is Romans 3:23
    - c. The Bible reveals man to himself as he can be Romans 5:1; 6:23
  - 6. The Word of God is like milk 1 Peter 2:2
    - a. We must have mile to grow as babies Hebrews 5:12-14

- b. Not meat first then milk, but milk first then meat
- c. Growth is a process
- 7. The Word of God is seed Luke 8:11
  - a. The seed must be planted
  - b. The seed must be planted to have fruit
