1. There is a time of research
 - a. How does God want us to live? Research! Acts 17:11; John 5:39; Isaiah 34:16
 - b. See how others lived Hebrews 11:4,5,7,8,20,21,22,24,31
2. There is the time of ripping out
 - a. This is the time for change! Ephesians 4:22 (put off); Hebrews 12:1-2 (lay aside); Colossians 3:5; 8-10 (mortify, put off); Jeremiah 1:10
 - b. Who are we going to serve Matthew 6:24
 - c. We can lay these things aside Hebrews 12:1-2
 - d. Fear can cause us not to do anything 2 Timothy 1:7; Revelation 21:8
 - e. Being ashamed can cause us not to do something also 2 Timothy 1:8 Romans 1:16
 - f. The love of the world does not need to be a part of our life 2 Timothy 4:10; 1 John 2:15-17
 - g. What we speak may need changing Ephesians 4:25, 29; 5:4
3. There is the time of rebuilding
 - a. We need to rebuild with patience Hebrews 12:1
 - b. Notice the plan and stay with the plan Hebrews 12:2; 5:8-9 (author and finisher)
 - c. There are some things that need to be added
 - i. Ephesians 4:24
 - ii. Colossians 3:10,12-24
 - iii. 2 Peter 1:5-11
