Introduction

- 1. Matthew 16:18-20
- 2. There is much confusion about the church today
 - a. Some will tell you to join the church of YOUR choice.
 - b. Look around while driving and see how many different religious groups are present
 - c. Can we make a decision about which church is the right church?
- 3. We need a clear understanding of what the scriptures teach about the church.
 - a. Because God has told us exactly what He wants!
 - b. We can not change His Word
- 4. Let us study these passages to discern what it is that God wants

II Discussion

- 1. Matthew 16:18-20
 - a. "Upon this rock"
 - i. The foundation was Peter's confession not Peter Matthew 16:16
 - ii. There is no other foundation 1 Corinthians 3:11
 - iii. Isaiah prophesied that Christ would be the foundation Isaiah 28:16 (Acts 4:11).
 - b. "I" The builder
 - i. Psalm 127:1; Matthew 15:13; Zechariah 6:11-13
 - ii. The Lord's church was not built by John the Baptist;
 - iii. The Lord's church was not built by Reformer Calvin or Luther
 - iv. The Lord's church was not built by a modern-day, self-proclaimed prophet Joseph Smith, Mary Baker Eddy, Charles Russell or Judge Rutherford
 - c. "Will build" The time of the establishment
 - i. The kingdom or church was to come with power Mark 9:1
 - ii. The power was to come when the Holy Spirit came Acts 1:8
 - iii. The Holy Spirit came on Acts 2: 1-4 therefore the church came on Pentecost
 - d. "My" The possessor
 - i. The church belongs to the Lord by virtue of purchase Acts 20:28; Ephesians 5:25
 - ii. The church belongs to Him because of His relationship (next weeks' sermon)
 - e. "church" The number
 - i. Does the text mean what it says?
 - ii. Did Jesus say "churches?"
 - iii. Did Jesus say "a church"
 - iv. Did Jesus say "one of many churches"
 - v. But Jesus did say "my church" singular in number
 - vi. The church is not a church among churches rather it is one Ephesians 1:22-23: 4:4-6
 - f. "the gates of hell shall not prevail against it" the test
 - i. Hell in this passage is hades (the unseen realm and has no reference to the character of a person) and refers to the doors of death
 - ii. Hades could not retain him Acts 2:27
 - iii. The gates of hell would not prevent Christ from being resurrected (Romans 1:4) and the church from being established.

- iv. Hells gates will not stop the church from continuing.
- g. "I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom" The authority
 - i. The Holy Spirit came upon the apostles on the day of Pentecost enabling them to unerringly issue the terms of entrance into the kingdom Acts 2:37-41
 - ii. The Inspired word of God is the standard of authority in religion Jude 3

III Conclusion

- 1. This is the church of the New Testament.
- 2. If we would do the same thing that those on Pentecost did we will be added to the same church
- 3. Will you Believe, Repent, Confess and Be baptized for the remission of your sins?
