 - i. Acts 2:40 can we save ourselves? Titus 3:5; John 6:28-29
 - ii. Eph 1:13 (NIV) ["and you also were included in Christ when you heard the word of truth..."].
 - iii. Grace only Eph 2:8; If is only by grace that we are saved, why are not all saved. Titus 2:11-12; 1 Tim 2:4; yet Matt 7:13-14

- 2. Our Salvation is because of the Love of God
 - a. His love is great Eph 2:4; John 3:16
 - b. God is love 1 John 4:8
 - c. This love is everlasting love Jeremiah 31:3

 - e. This love was commanded toward us while we were yet sinners Romans 5:6-10
- 3. Our Salvation is because of the **Grace** of God
 - a. We are saved by grace Eph 2:5,8
 - b. Salvation is by faith, that is might be according to grace Rom 4:16
 - c. Our calling is by grace and His purpose 2 Tim 1:9; 2 Thess 2:14
 - d. Peter wrote of the true grace 1 Peter 5:12
 - e. Grace abounds but has limits Rom 5:20-21, 6:1-2,14-15

 - a. His kindness is toward us Eph 2:7
 - b. God is kind Ps 117:2; 119; 76; Luke 6:35; Titus 3:4
