    - i. Incorruptible things of earth are subject to decay, God's things are incorruptible 1:23; 2 Corinthians 4:16-18
    - ii. Undefiled, without defect or flaw, High Priest Hebrews 7:26; Revelation 21:27 nothing defiled will enter heaven
    - iii. Fades not away it is not like the rose It is new every morning Revelation 21:1-2
- 3. Ready verse 5
  - a. To welcome the appearance of Jesus to claim the inheritance
  - b. Ready to preach Romans 1:15
  - c. Ready to give 2 Corinthians 8:11-12
- 4. Revealed in this last times
  - a. This is something presented to the senses, sight or hearing Romans 1:17; Acts 23:22

- b. They were to be ready for the second coming of Jesus 1:7; 4:7
- c. All will be revealed Ecclesiastes 12:14; 2 Corinthians 5:10-11
- 5. Rejoice verse 6
  - a. Admits trials 1:7; Acts 16
