- 1. Deuteronomy 32 This is one of the songs of Moses Deuteronomy 31:29-30
  - a. Verses 3 Listed are some of the greatness of our God
    - i. He is the Rock Verse 4
      - 1. Some things to think about when we mention God as our Rock
      - 2. He is immutable, immovable, impenetrable shelter,
    - ii. The Rock of our salvation verse 15
      - 1. He has saved them during the 40 years of wilderness wanderings
      - 2. He has sustained them during this time physically-food and water. Physical enemies
      - 3. Jushurun means an upright people, they were no longer indebted to Him (Romans 1:14) for any past favors nor did they have any dependence for the future
  - b. Now Moses tells them of their future
    - i. The forgotten God Verses 18, 30-31, 37-38 (Isaiah 17:10-11)
      - ii. He created us do we forget Him
      - iii. He preserves us do we forget Him
      - iv. He saves us do we forget Him
      - v. Where is God verse 38
      - vi. They had forsaken God Jeremiah 2:13; Malachi 1:6-8; Judges 10:14; Isaiah 47:12-13
- 2. 2 Samuel 22:2-3, 33
  - a. David is remembering what God had done, His protecting David in his time of need Verse 1
  - b. God is David's fortress, deliverer, trust, shield, horn of salvation (Luke 1:69), high tower, refuge and saviour
- 3. Isaiah 8:14; 28:16; Romans 9:32-33; 1 Peter 2:6-8
  - a. He is a foundation stone 1 Corinthians 3:11
  - b. Tried Stone, tried by men and rejected Romans 1:4
  - c. Precious stone 1 Peter 1:18-19
  - d. Corner Stone true and valuable
  - e. A living Stone, He is not dead
  - f. A stumbling stone and a rock of offense. Many were offended at Him, yet He had no sin

  - a. The rock that the church is built upon is Christ
  - b. It is a solid rock and one that will not be shaken

- d. The foolish man did not build his house on "the rock"
