- 2. Many charges are given in the Bible.
 - a. Noah to build the ark.
 - b. Abraham to leave Ur and go to Canaan

C. 2 Timothy 4:1-2 To preach the word of God.

1. What is to be done? Preach the word.

a. Titus 2:1 not what I like or not what is easy and not what is my or your opinion.

b. 2 Timothy 4:3-4 When it cost you your job.

- 2. When is it to be done?
 - a. IN season and out of season.
 - b. When you feel like it and when you don't feel like it.
 - c. When they like and don't like it.
- 3. How is it to be done?

a. Reprove - to find fault with, correct to reprehend severely, chide, admonish, to call to account, show one his fault.

b. Rebuke - stronger term to tax with fault, censure severely. Timothy had the right to do this without argument or quibbling from any opposition.

- c. exhort Admonish, to encourage, to comfort
- d. Longsuffering Patience
- e. Doctrine teaching.

b. Practice what we preach.

c. Teach only the simple word of God the best we can.
