Introduction

- 1. Romans 4:12
- 2. Abraham is one of the most talked about characters of the Bible
 - a. He is mentioned at least 231 times
 - b. Abram is mentioned 46 times
 - c. Matthew 1:1
- 3. There is a connections between Abraham and us Galatians 3:29
- 4. Look now at 1 John 3:7 there is the doing of righteousness
 - a. There is the standard of righteousness as He is righteous
 - i. Not our standard but His standard Jeremiah 10:23; Proverbs 23:7
 - b. There is the state of righteousness "in righteous based on the standard
 - c. There are the steps of righteousness "practices" NKJV "doeth"
 - i. This is the arriving at the state of righteousness
 - ii. There are then steps of righteous,
 - iii. Abraham will be our example

II Discussion Walking in the steps of Abraham

- 1. Genesis 12:1-4 the beginning
 - a. Genesis 11:27-32 introduced to Abram
 - b. Genesis 12:1-4
 - i. Get thee out verse 1
 - ii. He departed verse 4
 - iii. The verses in between are important but for our lesson today these two points need to be remembered
 - c. Hebrews 11:8 Abraham obeyed
 - i. He did not have to build an ark, He did not have to walk around a city, He did not have to dip seven times in the Jordan
 - d. Abraham has faith, Romans 10:17; Hebrews 11:1, 6, 8 because he obeyed
 - i. He obtained a good report, he is one of the fathers Hebrews 11:2
 - e. Is Abraham accepted of God here?
- 2. Genesis 15:6 The middle (continuous action)
 - a. A promise has been made Genesis 12:3 In thee shall families of the earth be blessed
 - b. Yet he is childless
 - c. He is told to so something, go outside and look at the stars and number them, so shall thy seed be 15:5
 - d. Genesis 15:6 is quoted in the New Testament Galatians, Romans and James
 - i. Galatians 3:18, by promise not law, it was 430 years before the law
 - ii. Romans 4:12 begin with verse 9, This was done before circumcision was given
 - 1. Not being weak in faith 4:19, he was 100 years old
 - 2. Romans 4:1-3 not by works but by faith
 - 3. Romans 4:20-24 it was written for us (remember this)
 - e. Abraham look at the stars, I made them from nothing, I can give you an heir through Sarah, Nothing is too hard for God Genesis 18:14
- 3. Genesis 22: ending or faith made perfect
 - a. James 2:20-22 Abraham's faith was made perfect

- b. Hebrews 11:17-19
- c. Go back to Genesis 22:1-19
 - i. Abraham did what God asked, take the heir of the promise and go offer him
 - ii. Notice Genesis 22:5 I and the lad will go and come again insert Hebrews 11:19
 - iii. He believed God would raise him up, but that was not what happened, in his mind he did, our plans are not God's plans
- d. There is nothing that stands between God and Abraham and he just proved that by offering his only son of promise
- 4. Application to us, we have Abraham as our example, and it was written for us
 - a. Our beginning, we have been called Matthew 11:28-30
 - i. Called out of the world 1 John 2;15-17
 - ii. Called out of darkness 1 Peter 2:9
 - iii. God calls us to leave 2 Corinthians 6:17
 - b. Our middle the challenge of faith, take God at His word Hebrews 11:38-39
 - i. We are to keep on believing, do not draw back
 - c. The perfecting of our faith, proving of our faith, testing of our faith
 - i. Abraham chose God over Isaac
 - ii. We are to choose God over father, mother Luke 14:26; Matthew 10:37

III Conclusion

- 1. Keep on believing
- 2. Have our faith made perfect
- 3. But we must start on this journey believing, repenting, confessing, baptized
- 4. Our faith this will continue to believe what God has said for us to do
- 5. Then our faith will be perfect in being tested and showing that we will chose God over anything else.
