- 2. There are different kinds of promises from God.
 - a. There are conditional promises and there are unconditional promises.
 - b. These in our text are precious because
 - 1. what they mean to the soul, and
 - 2. they are great because of what they include.
- 3. None of God's promise can be bought or merited by man.
- 4. God's promises are designed so you can:
 - 1. Escape the corruption that is in the world through lust.
 - 2. Partake of the divine nature.
- 5. All of God's promises center in Christ. 2 Corinthians 1:20
 - a. Yea means they are affirmed or declared.
 - b. Amen means there is no uncertainty in the proclamation, neither in the

fulfillment.
