- F. Salvation is better than gold. Mark 8:36-37
 - 1. Gold and silver will perish, but salvation in heaven is for eternity.
 - 2. Rom 6:23
- G. Treasure in Heaven is better than all the gold in the world. Matt 6:19-20

- H. Wisdom is better than gold. Proverbs 16:16; Job 28:12-19
