  - 1. Judged by what Jesus taught.

  - 3. It is a mark of wisdom to know that by which we will be judged by.
- D. John 17:14-15 Jesus gave the apostles the truth.
- E. John 18:38 the question is asked what is truth?
  - 1. This is the root of the problem!

  - 3. Many don't like the truth so it is easier not to believe the truth.
  - 4. Do we have the truth?
    - a. Guided into all truth. John 16:13
    - b. 2 Peter 1:3
    - c. Jude 3 "the faith"
