 - b. This will be for everyone Matthew 25:31-33
 - c. Every eye shall see Him Revelation 1:7
 - d. The time is unknown Mark 13:35-37; but God is the only one who knows Matthew 24:36
- 3. The dead in Christ will rise first 4:16; Colossians 3:4
 - a. This will all happen in the twinkling of an eye 1 Corinthians 15:52
- 4. The living saints will be caught up with Him in the air 4:17
 - a. 1 Corinthians 15:51-53
- 5. The righteous dead will meet Him in the air 4:17
 - a. Acts 1:9-11
 - b. John 14:1-3; 17:24
