  - b. He came into the world to save sinners. Luke 19:10 John 3:17
  - c. He offers the invitation. Matthew 11:28-30
  - d. The time to respond to the invitation is now 2 Corinthians 6:2

  - a. We must believe. John 8:24; Hebrews 11:6
  - b. We must repent. Luke 13:3
  - c. We must confess Romans 10:9-10; Acts 8:37
  - d. We must be baptized. Acts 2:38; 18:8 Romans 6:3-4; 1 Peter 3:21
  - e. We must live faithful Revelation 2:10
