 - a. There are two kind of commands
 - i. General commands
 - 1. This is just a command but does not tell us how to do something.
 - 2. Matthew 28:19-20 Go but how do we go? Boat, plane or automobile?
 - 3. We are to meet. John 4:23-24; Hebrews 10:25; 1 Corinthians 11:20
 - ii. Specific command
 - 1. This is when God specified what we are to do.
 - 2. Ark gopher wood Genesis 6:14, 22
 - 3. Sing (all) Ephesians 5:19; Colossians 3:16 (teaching one another)
 - 4. Baptism is commanded Acts 10:48
 - 5. Giving is commanded 1 Corinthians 16:1-2
- 2. Examples that which is to be imitated
 - a. The Lord's Supper on the first day of the week
 - i. Luke 22:19 in His memory
 - ii. 1 Corinthians 11:26 As often as ye eat the bread. How often?
 - iii. Acts 20:7 an example of them partaking of it
 - iv. We have the command to meet and an example to partake.
 - b. No example of instrumental music in the New Testament.
 - c. Example of baptizing Acts 8, 16
 - d. How did the apostles go? (Example)Walked, boat, rode? We can do the same we can walk, take a boat, or ride [automobile, plane, train, bicycle].
 - e. John 13 example of washing feet, but where is the background command?

 - a. Singing, then song book, tune, pitch the command is to sing!
 - b. Meeting, a place to meet the command is to meet
 - c. Lord's Supper, something to put the contents in. Luke 22:17-20
 - d. Container for the Giving
