- 3. No one will be called or commissioned as Isaiah but there are some qualities in this section that the church sorely needs today.
- 4. As Judah did not listen to Isaiah, so today people are not listening, are we learning from the things written afore time. Romans 15:4
- 5. Let us notice the qualities that the church needs today

II Discussion

- 1. To see God as He is: Isaiah 6:1-3
 - a. Majesty vs 1 (greatness)
 - i. How David felt about God 1 Chronicles 29:10-11
 - ii. God is clothed with majesty Psalm 93:1
 - iii. Isaiah tells of the majesty of God Isaiah 2:10
 - b. Holiness Vs 3
 - i. Moses song tells of the holiness of God Exodus 15:11 quoted Revelation 15:4
 - ii. The men of Bethshemesh who understood the holiness of God after some looked into the ark I Samuel 6:20
 - iii. Isaiah tells of the holiness of God Isaiah 6:3; 57:15
 - c. Greatness Vs 4
 - i. Moses prayer tells of the greatness of God Deuteronomy 3:24
 - ii. The Psalmist tells of the greatness of God Psalms 77:12-14; 104:1; 135:5; 145:3
 - iii. Isaiah declares the greatness of God Isaiah 12:6
 - d. Goodness
 - i. The Psalmist saw the goodness of God Psalms 25:8; 33:5; 34:8; 119:68; 145:7
 - ii. Isaiah declares the goodness of God Isaiah 63:7
- 2. To see ourselves as we truly are Vs 5
 - a. He was a man of unclean lips He was a sinner Romans 3:10, 23; Psalm 14:1
 - b. When we consider God and who He is then compared to Him we are unclean.
 - c. God must be personal not based on someone else. Philippians 2:12 Acts 16:30
- 3. To see others as they truly are Vs 5
 - a. This is to see their lost condition and that they need salvation Matthew 28:19-20; Mark 16:15-16
 - b. We have the treasure in earthen vessels 2 Corinthians 4:7
 - c. We are labors together with God 1 Corinthians 3:9; 2 Corinthians 6:1
 - d. Since they are lost we must take the Gospel to them Acts 8:4
- 4. To see forgiveness as it truly is Vs 6-7

- a. The cost of forgiveness, it cost somebody something!
- b. The great cost of forgiveness was the Son of God giving His life for us. 1 Timothy 2:4-6; 1 Peter 1:18-19
- 5. To see who needs to go do the work of the Lord vs 8
 - a. We are to go 2 Corinthians 4:7
 - b. If I don't do my part then it won't get done! Or someone else will have to stop what they are doing and do my job.
 - c. There is a need for elders, preachers and teachers who will answer the call?
