 - b. Being a Christian
 - i. We must be in Him
 - ii. Where all spiritual blessings are Ephesians 1:3

 - iv. Where redemption is Ephesians 1:7
 - v. We get into Christ by being baptized. Galatians 3:26-27

 - i. Right things 1 Peter 4:11; not adding to nor taking from; 2 Timothy 2:15 rightly dividing
 - ii. Matthew 12:34-36 thinking on false ideas will produce false doctrine Philippians 4:8
 - d. Don't worry
 - i. Matthew 6:19-34
 - ii. Matthew 13:22 let the cares of this world overcome us
 - iii. We are to let Him worry about it for He is up all night anyway 1 Peter 5:7
 - e. Pray
 - i. For everything
 - ii. Coming to the throne of grace, to fine grace to help in the time of need. Hebrews 4:16
 - f. Promised peace
 - i. Isaiah 26:3
 - ii. John 14:27 He promised peace before.

 - a. The true things. John 1:17; 8:32; 17:17; 18:38 has been explained

- b. Honest and just things not just legally required but morally and ethically right. How we treat others. Matthew 7:12
- c. Pure, moral purity, chaste, virtuous and morally sound. Titus 2:5
- d. Lovely lovable amiable. Agreeable to others
- e. Good report well-spoken of within and without
- f. Virtue manly strength and courage
- g. Praise that which is praiseworthy
- h. Thinking on the right things, not things of the world

 - a. Paul faced greater tribulations than most. 2 Corinthians 11:24-28
 - b. Contentment Hebrews 13:5-6
 - c. Christ was with Him every step of the way. 2 Timothy 4:8
