 - c. We do this by seeking first the kingdom of God Matthew 6:33

 - a. Paul had this confidence 2 Timothy 1:12; 4:8.
 - b. God is able to keep you from falling and has made plans for this to happen Jude 24; 2 Peter 1:5-11
 - c. I do not have to fear what men will do to me Hebrews 13:5-6
