 - i. Psalm 116:11 (Verse 4)
 - ii. Psalm 51:4
 - iii. Psalm 62:9
 - c. Therefore all people are under sin (II. is proven) verse 9
 - d. Scriptures from the Bible to prove this to be so. (Verses 10-18)
 - i. Psalm 14:1
 - ii. Psalm 53:1-3
 - iii. 1 Kings 8:46
 - iv. Psalm 5:9
 - v. Psalm 10:7
 - vi. Isaiah 59:7-8

- C. Justified by faith. Chapter 4
 - a. Was Abraham saved by a sinless life (works) or grace?
 - b. If a sinless life (works) then God owed him salvation.
 - c. When was Genesis 15:6 stated? Before Genesis 17
 - i. Was Abraham sinless?
 - ii. Is lying a sin? Genesis 20
 - iii. Revelation 21:8 says yes!
 - iv. But where was Lazarus? Luke 16:22
 - v. How was Abraham saved? Blood of Christ! Hebrews 9:15
 - vi. How is anyone saved today?
- D. Christ's work in this Justification. Chapter 5
- E. Man's work in this Justification. Chapter 6
 - a. Man must be baptized verses 3-4
 - i. This is where man contacts the blood of Christ! John 19:34; Revelation 1:5; Acts 22:16; Romans 6:3-4; 1 John 1:7
 - ii. After becoming a Christian you still need the blood of Christ to cleanse you of sin!
 - b. Man must live faithful Verses 7-23
 - i. Sin can no longer be our Master Verse 12-18

III But does that mean that Christians are sinless?

- 1. James 1:26 Control that tongue!
- 2. James 3:2 If we do, we are perfect (mature or sinless?).
- 3. James 3:8 The tongue can no man tame!
- a. If the tongue can be controlled that makes one perfect, can you control your tongue?
 - b. Have you never said anything out of the way?
 - c. Have you never hurt anyone's feelings?
 - d. Have you never sinned with your tongue?
 - e. The Bible says you can't do it, I believe the Bible, what about you?

IV. Was Paul sinless?

- 1. If he was sinless why did he have to buffet his body? 1 Corinthians 9:27
- 2. 1 Timothy 1:15 Paul says that he was the chief of sinners.
 - a. ("I am" which is the present tense not past tense. Present tense is used for the present. Does the tense of the verb mean anything?)

V. Was Simon sinless? Acts 8:9-24

- a. Was he saved? Acts 8:13 He contacted the Blood of Christ!
- b. Did he sin after that? Acts 8:22
- c. If no, why was he told to repent? Acts 8:22
- d. If no, what does being in the fall of bitterness and the bond of iniquity mean? Acts 8:23

VI. Was Peter sinless?

- 1. What does denying the Lord mean? Matthew 26:75
- 2. Why did Paul withstand Peter to the face? Galatians 2:11-24
 - a. What does "walked not uprightly according to the truth of the Gospel" mean if he was sinless?

VII. Was the church at Corinth sinless?

Conclusion

- 1. If it is the case that a man can be considered sinless, then it is the case that man has no need of Christ.
- 2. Peter and Paul considered themselves not to be sinless
- 3. It is not the case that a man can be considered sinless
- 4. Therefore man has the need of the blood of Christ. Romans 6:3-4 1 John 1:7
