 - d. Memorials are used as a teaching device Joshua 4:1-7

II Discussion

- 1. The proper response to the Lord's Supper
 - a. Visualization or discerning of Christ's death
 - i. Discerning means discriminating what the bread and cup represent; not as in a common meal; proper manner
 - ii. What does the cross mean? (Isaiah 53) I Corinthians 11:26
 - iii. Thinking of a song or scriptures may help
 - b. Appreciation for Christ
 - i. Ingratitude is powerful to lead one into sin Romans 1:21
 - ii. Gratitude is powerful for good Psalm 100:4 Ephesians 5:20; Philippians 4:6; Colossians 3:15,17
 - c. Dedication I Corinthians 11:28 Examination
 - i. It is a time for renewing dedication to Christ
 - ii. It is a time for reaffirming allegiance to Christ
 - d. Proclamation 1 Corinthians 11:26 declare
 - i. Declare faith in the vicarious death of Christ
 - ii. Proclaim faith in His second coming
- 2. The proper regularity of the Lord's Supper
 - a. The "oftenness" of the Lord's Supper, annually, quarterly, monthly, weekly, or daily?
 - b. The observation is weekly
 - i. In His memory Luke 22:19
 - ii. We are commanded to assemble Hebrews 10:25
 - iii. The church was coming together 1 Corinthians 11:18, 20, 33
 - iv. The church did this upon the first day of the week Acts 20:7
