Introduction

- 1. 2 Thessalonians 3:1
- 2. Paul wanted the Thessalonians to pray that the word might have a free course.
 - a. The Olympic games were held every four years in Athens and Corinth.
 - b. Paul uses these games as an illustration several times 1 Corinthians 9:24-27; Hebrews 12:1-2; 2 Thessalonians 3:1
 - c. The free course would be free from obstacles, not hurtles or barriers to overcome.
- 3. It is also impossible to have a right relationship with Jesus without having a right relationship with and regard for His word. John 14:15; 1 John 5:13
- 4. If the word of the Lord is to run, it will be because brethren who love God and His truth actively proclaim the Gospel.
- 5. "Glorified" here means to make renowned, render illustrious i.e. to cause the dignity of some person or thing to become manifest and acknowledged.
- 6. What are some hurdles that some put in the way of the Gospel so that it does not have a free course?

II Discussion

- 1. Prejudice is one hurdle that some put in the way of the Gospel
 - a. Prejudice is "preconceived judgment or opinion."
 - b. The word "prejudice" is not found in the Bible but the idea is:
 - i. Ahab 1 Kings 22
 - ii. Naaman 2 Kings 5
 - iii. People who have closed their eyes to the truth. Matthew 13:15
 - iv. The Jews were prejudice against the Gentiles Acts 21:28; 22:21-22; Galatians 2:6-12
 - c. Some today may be prejudiced against the Gospel
 - i. It might be baptism
 - ii. It might be church of Christ
 - iii. It might be obedience
 - iv. It might be worship
 - v. It might be singing without instruments
 - d. The proper attitude is essential if men are saved. John 7:17
- 2. Religious error may be a hurdle that some put in the way of the Gospel
 - a. The fact of religious error
 - i. Predicted by Jesus Matthew 7:15
 - ii. Proclaimed by Paul 2 Thessalonians 2:9-12
 - iii. The idea that it does not make any difference what you believe does not make any since in the Bible.
 - b. Error was taught in the New testament times
 - i. John 1 John 4:1; but 1 John 5:13
 - ii. Peter 2 Peter 2:1-3 but 2 Peter 1:3, 5-11
- 3. Indifference is a hurdle that some may place in the way of the Gospel
 - a. Indifference is a lack of feeling or commitment for or against a thing
 - b. See in the church at Laodecia Revelation 3:15-17

- c. Indifference can be produced by the cares of this life Luke 8:14
- d. Instead of being indifferent to spiritual ideas men ought to be addicted to them. 1 Corinthians 16:15
- 4. Materialism is often a hurdle that some place before the Gospel
 - a. This is a world of things Luke 12:15-21
 - b. Materialism contrasted Matthew 4:4; 6:19-21; 16:24-26
 - c. There is something more important than thing, i.e. the saving of the soul. James 1:21-22; 1 Peter 1:9, 22-23.
