 - c. Not pilfering (NKJV pilfering) honest, true, not wasting. Luke 16:12-13
 - d. Adorn (make attractive) I Timothy 2:9

 2. We say, "Worship God," to the world, but then don't come ourselves. John 4:24
 3. We say, "God is first in our life and ought to first in yours" but anything and everything comes before God. Matthew 6:33
- E. Consecration and devotion makes Christianity attractive. Ruth 1:16; Joshua 24:15
 1. Daniel prayed three times daily and was thrown into the lion's den. Daniel 6:10
 2. Do we spend time with God or only when it is convenient?
 3. Would you buy a car that only started when it wanted to start?
