1. Hebrews 11:6
2. There are some things we can do without, but there are some things we cannot afford to be without.
3. In the study of Hebrews the word without is used 22 times
4. There are some interesting uses of this word.
5. Let us notice them this morning!

II Discussion

- A. We have a High Priest without sin. Hebrews 4:15
 1. Jesus is our High Priest. Vs 14
 2. We need not give up on what we have. Vs 14
 3. He was tempted just like we are; yet He did not sin!
 4. Because of this we can come to the throne of God, obtain mercy and grace to help in the time of need.
- B. There is no remission of sin without blood. Hebrews 9:22
 1. Paul is discussing the Old Law and its ordinances Vs 1-10 Notice vs. 7
 2. Christ has offered for us a better sacrifice. Vs 11-14 notice vs. 14
 3. The first was dedicated with blood. Vs 18
 4. Without the shedding of blood is no remission of sin. Vs 22
 5. Christ offered Himself for our salvation
- C. Without faith it is impossible to please Him. Hebrews 11:6
 1. He tells us what faith is Vs 1
 2. Based on evidence we know that God formed the world. Vs 2
 3. Doing what God said, Able offered up a more excellent sacrifice than Cain.
 4. Without faith we cannot please God, do you have faith?
- D. Without which no man shall see the Lord. Hebrews 12:14
 1. We must have peace Matthew 5:8
 2. We must be holy. 1 Peter 1:16 Set apart for use by God
 3. Without these things we cannot see God!
 4. How can see God? Notice the next one
- E. We must come to Him without the camp. Hebrews 13:11-13
 1. The sacrifices were brought without the camp: the peace offering. Leviticus 4:12; the sin offering, Leviticus 4:21; the water of purification Number 19:3-20
 2. When the children of Israel sinned with the golden calf, the tent was taken outside the camp and those that sought God had to go there! Exodus 33:7
 3. Christ was crucified outside the gates of Jerusalem. John 19:16-17
 4. One must submit themselves to God and go to Him to receive remission, the blessings of salvation. Are you willing?

III Conclusion

1. Since we have the perfect High Priest, will you not have faith in Him that He will remit your sins, become holy by coming to His blood offered without the camp?

2. Will you not humbly submit yourself to Him and obey Him in Baptism and have your sins washed away?
