

The Paschal Lamb a type of Christ

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Introduction

1. Jesus is called the Lamb of God. John 1:29
2. There are illustrations from the Old Testament to help us understand what Christ should mean to us today. Hebrews 10:1
3. One must understand something of the Old Testament to understand some NT passages. 1 Corinthians 5:7
4. We learn of the Passover in Exodus 12. Which is the background for 1 Corinthians 5:7
5. Jesus was crucified during this feast Luke 22:15;
6. This morning the lesson will consist of seeing how Christ and the Passover Lamb are similar.

Discussion

1. The Passover lamb was without blemish Exodus 12:5, Christ was/is without sin Hebrews 4:15; 1 Peter 2:21-22
2. The Passover lamb was taken out of the flock. Deuteronomy 16:2. Christ was taken out Abraham, the tribe of Judah. Matthew 1:1-2
3. The Passover lamb was separated from the flock. Exodus 12:1-6; Christ was separated from sinners. Hebrews 7:26
4. The Passover Lamb was the best of the flock. Exodus 12:5. Christ was the best. John 3:16; 6:38; 10:17-18; 17:5
5. The Passover Lamb was sacrificed before the salvation of Israel Exodus 12:5. Jesus died before man could be saved. Hebrews 9:15-17, 26; 10:1-20; Luke 23:44-46
6. The Passover Lamb was to complete Exodus 12:9; Psalm 34:20; Christ had no bone broken John 19:31-37; 1 Corinthians 10:17 unity
7. The Passover Lamb must be eaten Exodus 12:8; Christ is the bread of life John 6:48-51
8. The Passover Lamb was to be eaten with bitter herbs and unleavened bread Exodus 12:8,15; Matthew 16:24; Luke 14:26-33; 1 Corinthians 5:7
9. The Passover Lamb was to be eaten yearly, Exodus 12:14-28; We remember the Lord's death every first day of the week. Acts 20:7
10. The Passover was until the end of the Jewish age Exodus 12:14; we are to remember the Lord's death until he comes again. 1 Corinthians 11:26
11. The Passover Lamb's blood was to be applied to do door post. Exodus 12: 7; Christ blood must be applied to us. 1 Peter 1:18-19; Revelation 1:5; Acts 22:16; Romans 6:3-4

2. The blood had to be applied to the door post of the house in which Israel was to have death Passover them, will you have the blood of the lamb applied to your heart to live spiritually forever?
