2. Fact The most High ruleth in the kingdom of men Daniel 4:17
 - a. And giveth it to whomsoever he will." The rest of the verse
 - b. Proverbs 14:34 Righteousness exalteth a nation: but sin is a reproach to...
 - c. Psalm 33:12 Blessed is the nation whose God is the Lord; and the people
 - i. It does not say, blessed is the nation who has the most troops, tanks, guns or the most nuclear warheads or superior Air Force.
 - d. Joshua 7 Israel, with a superior army, was defeated at Ai because of their disobedience.
 - e. 2 Kings 17 Israel was overcome by Assyria and taken off into captivity because of sin
 - f. 2 Kings 24 & 25 Judah was carried away into Babylon because of her rebellion against God
 - g. God has blessed America. America is not grateful, else its sins would not grow worse and worse with each passing year.
 - h. For the salvation of our souls, we need to be a penitent, thankful, righteous people; but also for the welfare of our nation.
3. Fact The Lord thy God is a merciful God. Deuteronomy 4:31
 - a. Jeremiah 3:12 "I am merciful, saith the Lord."
 - b. 2 Chronicles 7:14 "If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble..."
 - c. Merciful and Merciless are next to each other in the dictionary, but poles apart in meaning.
 - d. Isaiah 55:6-7 Seek ye the Lord while
 - e. God's mercy depends on our repentance and submission to His will.
4. Fact God will never leave nor forsake His children Hebrews 13:5-6.
 - a. God can't leave us for His credibility is at stake
 - b. I might leave Him, but He cannot leave me Hebrews 6:18.
 - c. Matthew 6:33

- d. Philippians 4:19 But my God shall supply all your need according to His riches
- e. Ephesians 3:20-21 Now unto him that is able
