 1. 436 times is the word "heard" used in the NT alone, this is just this word!
 2. God never demanded anything without showing how it was to be done. Matthew 3:15
 3. John 2:5 whatsoever he saith do it!
 4. Him ye shall hear in all things or else! Acts 3:22-23
 5. Hearing ye shall hear and shall not understand. Matthew 13:13-15 is not what God wants and never has!
 6. Acts 2:22, 33, 37 They heard and they understood; are you as honest?
 7. 2 Timothy 3:16-17; 2 Peter 1:3 To equip up for all that we need.
